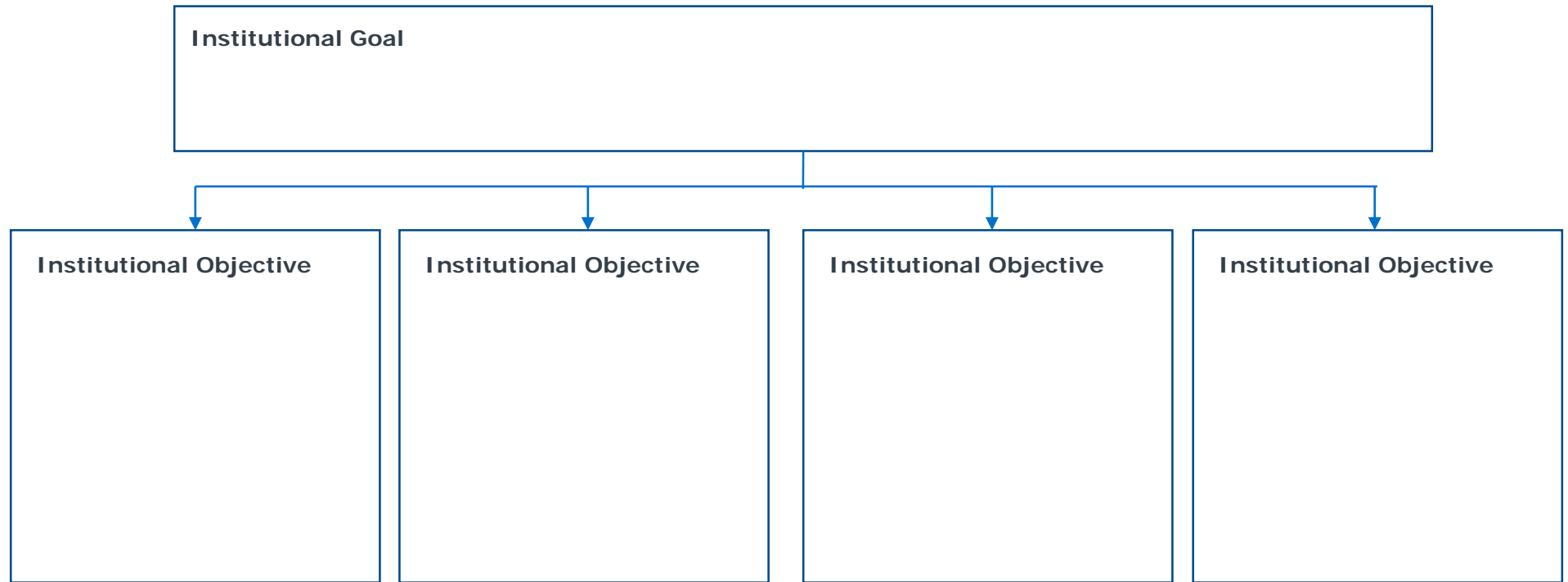


# Tool 15: Goals Cascade Workshop Exercise

## Strategic Goals IT Cascade Worksheet

**Instructions:** Use the boxes below to document IT components and activities required or implied by a specific institutional goal/objective. An IT component is an aspect of the institutional goal/objective that involves the use of technology or services provided by IT. An IT activity is a specific action or process undertaken by IT that enables the IT component. Note that there may be more than one activity per component; likewise, some activities may support multiple components.
