## Why Look at Completion Rates?



### The High Cost of Credits Taken But Not Earned

### **Longer Time to Degree**

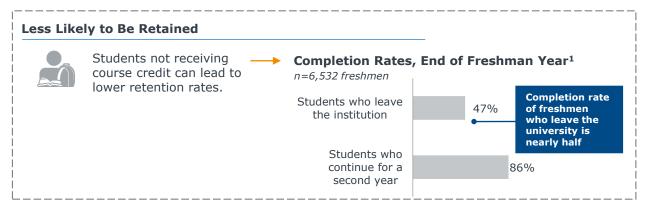


One institution found that six unproductive credits can lead to an extra four months of time to degree.

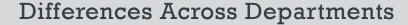
### **Potential Loss of Financial Aid or Scholarship**



Many aid packages or scholarships are dependent on a student having a minimum GPA or full time status.



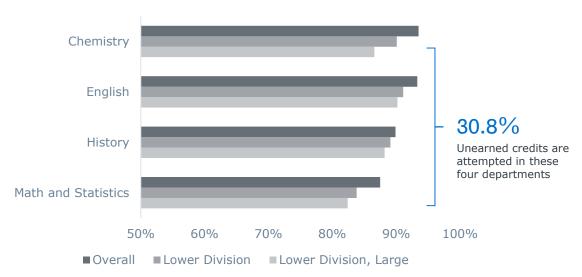
Average end-of-freshman-year completion rate at one regional comprehensive university.





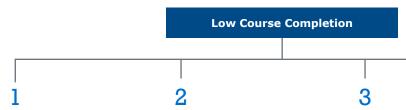
### **Departmental Differences Across the APS Collaborative**

# Common Root Causes of Low Completion





### Academically Unprepared

- Students with low high school GPAs or who attended academically weak institutions and lack critical study skills
- Contributing factor, but high school GPA and standardized test scores are often poor predictors of classroom performance

### First Year Struggles

- Financial, personal, or emotional issues can prevent students from fully engaging in coursework
- Challenging to address in classroom, better suited for counseling and advising staff

# Student Demographics

- Factors such as socioeconomic background or status as a first generation student have been associated with performance
- Institutions can address disparities related to demographic characteristics through support services or inclusive pedagogical approaches

# Instructor Variation

- Differences in grading philosophy and pedagogical style can impact student success in the classroom
- A major driver of higher DFW rates that can be addressed with support for improved pedagogy

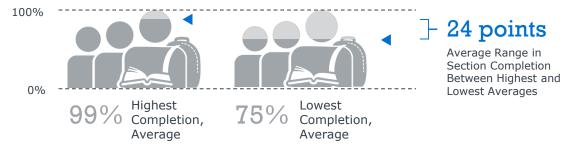

## How Much Variation Is Expected Across Sections?

Range of Section Completion Rate: The difference between the highest and lowest completion rates for sections of the same course

### Range of Section Completion Rates<sup>1</sup>



### A Deeper Dive: Average Section Completion Rate Range in Gateway Courses<sup>2</sup>

Analysis of 34 institutions in the APS Collaborative found that **Calculus** and **English** have the greatest variation among sections of the same course.

Intro to Biology 23% Intro to English 38% Calculus I 38% Intro to Psychology 25%

Intro to Chemistry 23%

Methodology: Average of range of completion rate for each course with five or more sections at each school in the collaborative. Academic Year 2017: n=51.

Methodology: Identified introductory courses at each institution, then calculated average range of completion rate for each course with two or more sections at each school in the collaborative. Academic Year 2016; n=34.

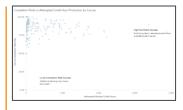

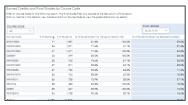

### **Illuminating Impact Through Drilldown Analyses**



Highlighted **six departments** with over 8,000 unearned credit hours over three years

Prioritized **eight gateway courses** with the most unearned credit hours

Sought to reduce **instructor variation** in section completion rates among teaching assistants

**Redesigned TA training** at the beginning of term to focus on course completion, leveraging EAB's Course Completion Playbook

### **Impact After First Term**

1.5% increase in completion rates in 7 targeted gateway courses

**Anticipating Additional Impact**
