### Your Institution's Custom Cohorts





#### Criteria for Cohort Creation

- Each institution can create up to 3 custom cohorts, consisting of 5-15 institutions
- To preserve anonymity, a cohort cannot contain less than five institutions

### **Creating Cohorts at Your Institution**

- Dedicated consultant provides list of available institutions, including size, Carnegie Classification, and region
- Value lead works with stakeholders to determine type of cohort, such as peer, aspirational, or regional, as well as selects institutions to include in each cohort
- Executive sponsor or value lead approves cohort selections and communicates decisions to users across campus

### **Changing Your Cohorts**

- Cohorts may be changed three times a year during "open enrollment" periods in February, June, and October
- Institutions may want to make changes, since more and more members will be added to the list of available institutions for benchmarking

### When to Use the APS Benchmarks Dashboard

The APS Benchmarks and APS dashboards work together to help answer your questions. Use the APS Benchmarks dashboard to view data at a high-level, then further investigate your question using the APS dashboard.



# Configuration Mapping Methodology



#### **Attributes Configured for Benchmarking**

Department, Costs, Course Type, Course Division, Instructor Type, Instructor Rank, Instructor Type, Student Classification, Student Level, Term

### Sample APS Standardized Mappings



#### Departments

- Identified 43 standard departments by reviewing member configurations
- Used CIP codes, as well as manual review, to map each institution's departments to one of the 43 standard departments

#### Course Types

- Used member configurations for the APS dashboard
- Reviewed course type descriptions, campus codes, and maximum enrollment to identify seven standard course types





- Is the department's attempted student credit hours trending like the cohort?

#### Course Completion



Earned credit hour and course completion rate metrics



- Which departments in my college have course completion rates below the benchmark?
- What is the difference in course completion rate between my department and the cohort?

#### Course Planning



Class size and fill rate metrics



- Are my department's courses more full than the cohort?
- Which departments in my college have fill rates less than the benchmark?

# The Right Tab for Your Question cont.




#### **Tabs in APS Benchmarks Dashboard**

#### Other Departments



- What are the top three departments offered by my cohort, but not by my institution?
- How many members of my cohort offer Nursing and how is enrollment trending?

#### Instructional Workload



- Are my department's tenured and tenure track staff teaching more or less median sections than the cohort?
- How does the median student credit hours taught by my adjunct instructors compare to the cohort?

#### Instructional Costs



- What are the three highest cost departments in my college compared to the cohort?
- What factors are contributing to the high costs and how can they be reduced?
