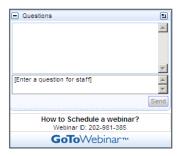

"I can't wait to get started at GSU, mv dream school!" **Referrals to Perimeter College**

2,064

Roughly 7% of applicants referred to Perimeter College for associate degree first

"Perimeter? This isn't what I thought I'd do..." **Perimeter Enrollments**

Of those referred, just 10% of applicants enroll at Perimeter

Spotlighting What Makes GPC Great



Advisors promoting clear opportunities for transfer, balanced with celebrating all that Perimeter College has to offer



Updating school branding to reflect its place at the university, rather than a separate entity altogether





Underscoring the savings realized from starting at Perimeter and transferring after 30 credits



Creating Clear Academic Pathways

Different Stages of Curricular Redesign Helped Garner Faculty, Staff Buy-in

How GSU Perimeter Created Pathways



- ✓ Minimal faculty input in initial build phase
- ✓ Three advisors from centralized advising office mapping existing curriculum
- ✓ Each map contain many general electives



G2Second-gen
curricular map

- ✓ Replaced general electives with **faculty** recommendations for success
- ✓ Trained frontline advisors with faculty and advising administration input

Lessons Learned



Train key leaders in project management and crucial conversations



Have planned meetings to review and enhance maps



Host process mapping sessions to explain how maps should be used

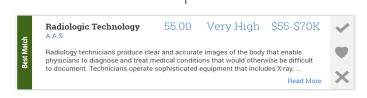
Charlotte uses Navigate's Personality Profile tool to explore community college pathways that map to her interests and preferred subjects.

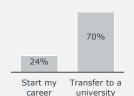

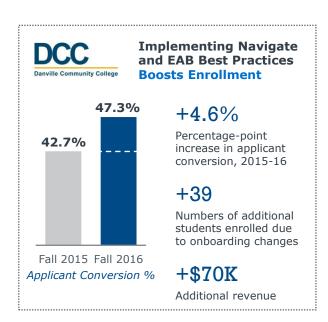


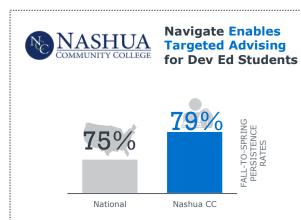
GSU-PC students agree that compared to the past, using Navigate for course selection was faster & easier





Moving the Dial on Applicant Conversion Rate, Persistence, and Retention





The extra advising capacity afforded by Navigate is then focused on developmental education students. The added attention has raised persistence rates for this student population 4%-points above national average.
