

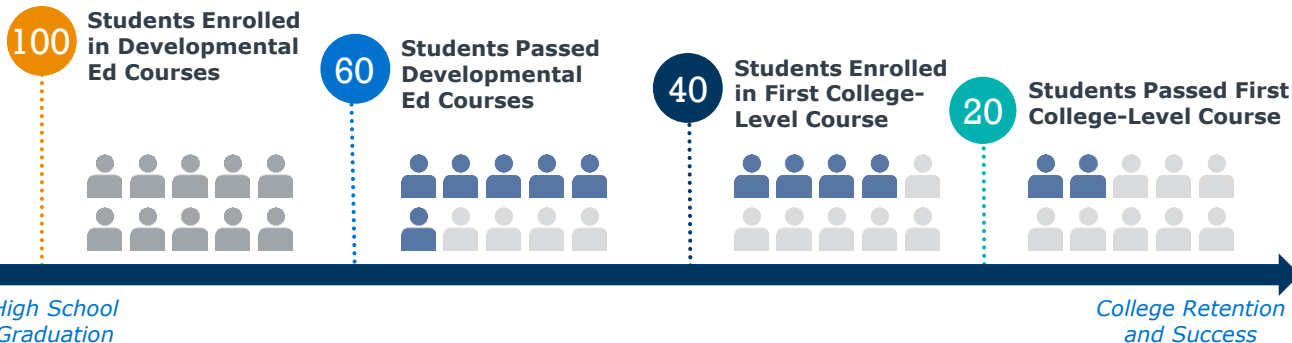

Completion Rates in Intro College-Level Courses<sup>1</sup>



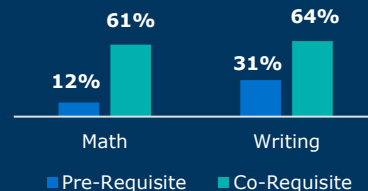
Offers developmental education along side introductory, college-level courses

Aligns developmental ed and college-level content to help faculty reinforce foundational concepts
