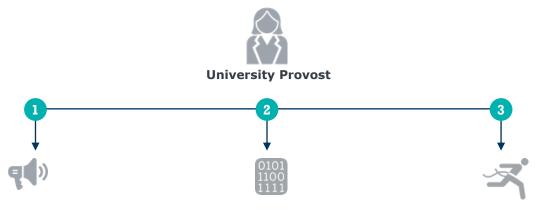

Break Down Silos

Re-Org When Necessary

- Re-organized Academic Affairs org to center on student success metrics
- Now includes representatives from admissions, financial aid, student accounts, and advising, for wholistic student experience
- Created new position for Associate Vice Chancellor of Student Success and Enrollment Management (combination of two previously separate roles)

Center Services Virtually & Physically

- Re-imagined the campus library
- AVC of Student Success and Enrollment Management spearheads Bronco One Stop Advising Center



Constantly train! FSU runs frequent **trainings** across campus including "train the trainer" style sessions to scale efforts.



Use Navigate for new initiatives. FSU runs financial aid and admissions campaigns, promotes the 30/60/90 Graduate on Time initiative, and recruits for year-round classes.
