

# **Courses Not Applied Tab**

## What is the Courses Not Applied Tab?

The Courses Not applied tab is located inside the Major Tile, after a student clicks "View Detail". This tab will list the courses a student entered into Portal that do not apply to their degree.

#### **Feature Overview**

When a student clicks View Detail on their chosen Major Tile, they can view their Degree Completion Page. A student can then review the Courses Not Applied tab to understand which of their courses will not apply to the chosen program.
