Key Details

Key Message 1

Safety is the top priority for our students, staff, and community.

Supporting Points

- 1. We immediately notified the authorities.
- 2. We have systems in place for this of situation (e.g., school resource officers, response plans).
- 3. We are providing additional police and counseling support to [school] as needed.

Key Message 2

Law enforcement is responding appropriately.

Supporting Points

- 1. Authorities are investigating the rumor/threat.
- 2 Law enforcement officers are coordinating with [school'] to investigate.
- 3. We will share more information as it becomes available.

Key Message 3

Parents should take three actions to support the district.

Supporting Points

- Stay home; don't go to your child's school.
- Turn to reliable sources for additional information, [name some sources].
- 3 Help stop the spread of unverified rumors.
