



#### Region in Focus: Midwest

- The Midwest includes the states of Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, South Dakota, and Wisconsin.
- Unless stated otherwise, this report analyzes online job postings from July 2021 to June 2022.

#### Key Takeaways

- **Remote Work:** Job postings advertising remote work account for 9.51% of postings in the higher education industry compared to 19.08% of postings in all other industries.
- In-Demand Titles: The higher education industry more frequently advertises for "System Administrator", "Specialist", and "Analyst" positions in all job postings (i.e., "Programmer Analysts," "IT Specialists," and "Business Systems Analysts"). Among all other industries, "Engineer" and "Developer" positions account for nine of the top ten titles in all job postings. The most frequently advertised job title is "Systems Administrators" in the higher education industry and "Software Engineers" in all other industries.
- **Technical Support:** The higher education industry more heavily emphasizes technical support roles in job postings compared to all other industries. While employers in the higher education industry request the skills "technical support" and "help desk support" in 14.67% and 10.24% of all postings on average monthly, respectively, employers in all other industries request "these same skills in 7.65% and 4.94% of postings on average monthly, respectively.
- Skill Specificity: While programming languages are the most highly demanded skills in both industry groups, all other industries more frequently request specific programming and software tools, such as "Docker," "React.js," and "RESTful API." Employers in the higher education industry request the skills "operating systems" and "information systems" at approximately double the rate of employers in all other industries (16.37% compared to 8.23% on average monthly for "operating systems" and 13.32% compared to 6.29% on average monthly for "information systems"). Additionally, the higher education industry more frequently advertises non-technical IT skills, such as "project management," "business process", "workflow management", and "data management."
- **Experience Levels:** All other industries generally request slightly greater years of experience in job postings than the higher education industry. In all postings, the median years of experience requested of applicants is five years for all other industries compared to three years for the higher education industry.
- **Education Levels:** The higher education industry more frequently advertises desired education levels in both remote and non-remote job postings compared to all other industries. While the higher education industry lists desired education levels in 86.46% of all postings and 87.91% of remote postings, all other industries list desired education levels in 64.02% of all postings and 60.66% of remote postings.




# Most Commonly Advertised Job Titles for IT Professionals (Higher Education)


#### Percentage of Job Postings Advertised by Remote Status (All Other Industries)<sup>1</sup>







#### Top 50 Skills Requested of IT Professionals (Higher Education)



n = 1,556,377 job postings July 2019 – June 2022





# Comparison of Remote Work in Higher Education vs. Other Industries


#### Most Commonly Requested Skills of Remote IT Applicants (Higher Education)


#### Most Commonly Advertised Job Titles for Remote IT Applicants (Higher Education)


# Most Commonly Requested Skills of Remote IT Applicants (All Other Industries)


#### Median Years of Experience Requested of Remote IT Applicants (Higher Education)
