What is Course Equivalencies?

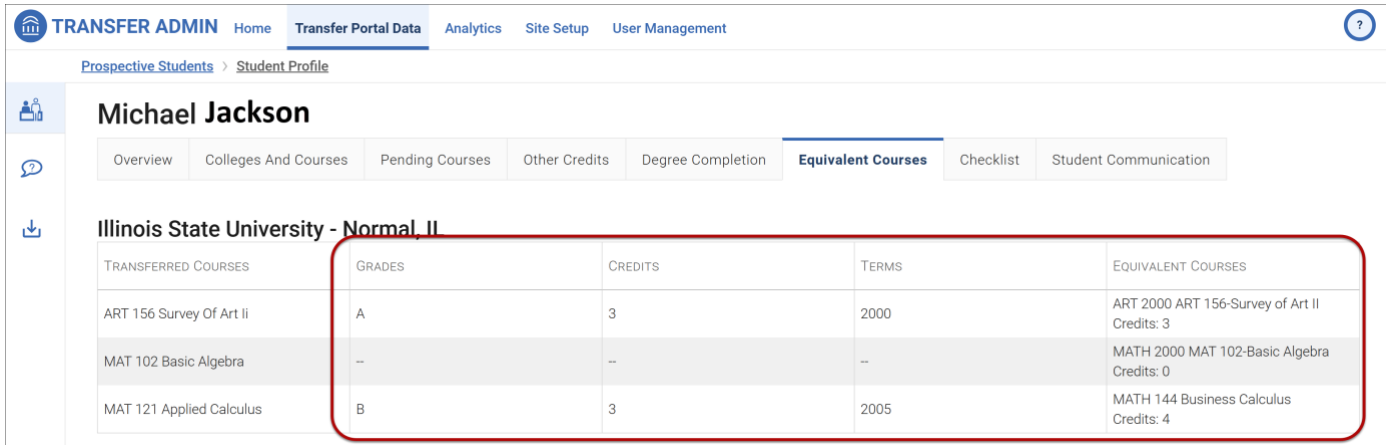
The Course Equivalency feature is designed for prospective transfer students. This optional feature allows both students and staff to view equivalent courses by college submission. Students will find an Equivalent Courses tab displaying matching courses, while staff can access detailed equivalency information through the Prospective Student Table. When enabled, an Equivalent Courses table is added to the Degree Requirement page, highlighting transferred courses, titles, grades, credits, terms, and how they fulfill requirements.

Feature Overview

When the Course Equivalency view is enabled, the view will differ depending on if you have the Refine Estimate feature enabled.

Equivalent Courses with Refine Estimate Enabled Example

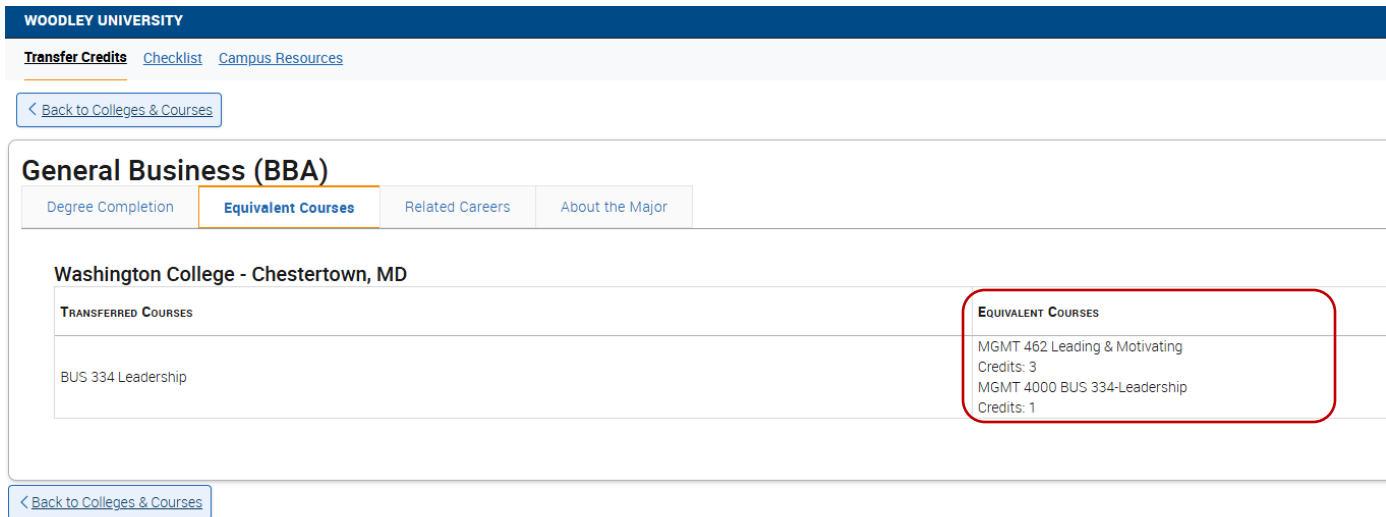
Student Experience

Once programs of interest have been selected and transfer courses submitted, the student can navigate to the View Details for each program by:

1. On the Credits tab and Schools and Majors sub-tab, click **View Detail** for a program.

FAQs

Only one Equivalent Course is displayed

The Transfer Portal will show one equivalent course that is selected by our algorithm as the best fit articulation to maximize credit. If multiple equivalent courses exist, we are unable to change which course is displayed.

Courses Not Applied

With the Course Equivalency view turned on, it replaces the Courses Not Applied tab because within the Course Equivalency screen, it is included in the courses not applied section.

Empty Equivalent Courses

If there are empty equivalent courses - those would be in the courses not applied section and could be because either:

- There is a course that was previously reviewed, and the transfer course rule is built in the school's system, but there is no equivalent course connected to the rule.
- There is a rule that says the course cannot be accepted alone, there are other courses required along with that course and therefore it has not fulfilled the full equivalency requirement to display it.

Inactive Course Equivalencies

Inactive course equivalencies are not evaluated or displayed.
