OPPORTUNITY

Siloed Data Systems and an Urgent Need for Deeper Insights

AU's fragmented data landscape, with information spread across siloed data systems, made access and analysis laborious and time-consuming. As AU's president prepared to kick off their new institutional strategic plan at an upcoming Board of Trustees meeting, she sought a partner that could rapidly build an executive-level dashboard to serve as a single source of data, tracking KPI benchmarks and goals across every facet of the strategic plan.

SOLUTION

Unifying Data and Providing Board-Level Insight on Key Performance Indicators

EAB's Edify team is partnering with AU to integrate multiple campus data systems into the Edify platform, which will provide them with a central data warehouse that serves as a single source of truth for all data questions. The team successfully launched the executive KPI dashboard in just two months.

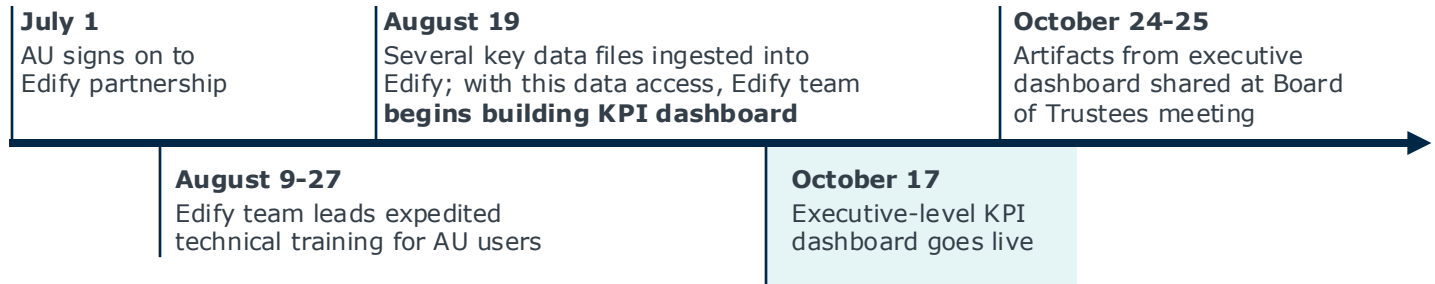

KPI Dashboard Makes it Easy to Track Benchmarks and Milestones

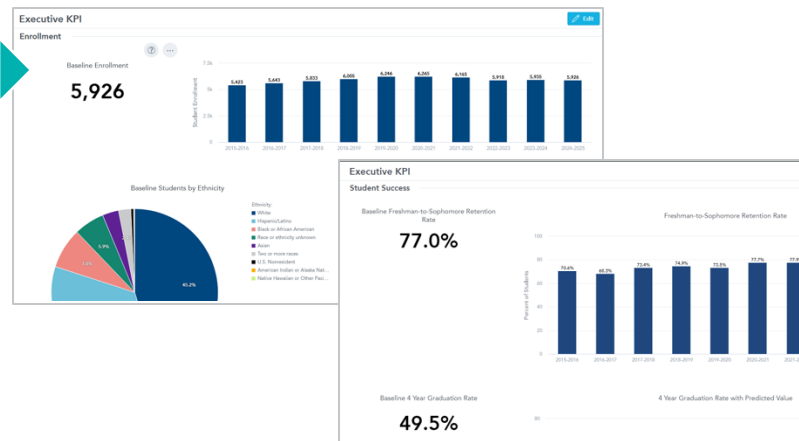
Connecting the Dots Across Functional Areas

AU's president shared artifacts from the KPI dashboard at a Board of Trustees meeting, demonstrating how the institution will both track and nimbly inflect progress toward goals in the new strategic plan. By pulling in data from multiple campus systems, the dashboard ensures everyone is working from the same source of truth, and can connect the dots to see how trends, initiatives, and shifts in one functional area can influence others.

What's Next for Edify at AU?



Expanded Data Integration: Integrate additional campus data sources into Edify to create a comprehensive data lake



Standardized Reports: Recreate existing university reports, including those used for accreditation requirements, within Edify for easier access and consumption



Data Democratization: Promote greater data-driven decision-making across campus by expanding the KPI dashboard with more granular data for utilization by the entire Cabinet
